## 1. Introduction

The preferred format style is LaTeX 2.09 two column article style.10pt. or LaTeX 2e could be used as well. Where MS Word or other word processors are used for the manuscript, please adhere to the style and guidelines described below to ensure uniformity of the final printed proceeding of the conference.

### 1.1. General Instructions

The maximum length of the papers are 4 pages, including figures, equations and references. Overlength pages charges amount to USD 50.- per page and has to be paid together with the registration. Manuscript should be prepared in English. Papers must be delivered camera ready. Submitted manuscripts have to be single sided and printed on white paper A4 size. Other sizes will not be accepted. Please, do not number the pages on the printed side. Page numbers should be written in soft pencil on the back side of each page. Each paper must be accompanied by a completed and signed copyright form. Copyright form can be obtained on:

Papers received without a signed copyright form will be discarded from the proceedings. Final papers should be submitted in electronic form in postscript format to:

Also 3 copies of printed version unfolded in a hard envelope are required to be received by mail before January 31, 2001 to the address:

All submissions will be reviewed. The form of presentation of accepted submissions (oral or poster) will be decided by the program committee. Authors may wish to include their preference.

The organisation claims the right to discard submitted material from further processing that do not meet these instructions.

### 1.2. Style Guidelines

All manuscripts must be single - spaced, in the specified two - column format. Margins settings: top 2 cm (0.8 inch), bottom 2.5 cm (1 inch), left 2 cm (0.8 inch), right 2 cm (0.8 inch), column separation 0.8 cm (0.3 inch). For the text is used a Roman font 10 pt. Justify columns both left and right.

#### 1.2.1 Paper Title

The paper title should be centred across the top of the two columns on the first page. Used font is Roman 14 pt. boldface.

#### 1.2.2 Authors' Name(s)

The authors' name(s), affiliation(s), mail and e-mail address(es) should appear below the title, centred across the top of the two columns on the first page. Used font is Roman 10 pt.. In the case of multiple authors with the same address please put this address only once.

#### 1.2.3 Headings

Headings are flush left, used font is Roman 10 pt. boldface. Please leave 1 blank line between the headings and the text.

### **1.2.4 Math, Figures, Tables and Graphs**

All equations should be numbered in the brackets on the right margin in Arabic numerals. Figures, tables and graphs should be included in text and numbered in Arabic numerals. Captions should appear bellow. Used font is Roman 10 pt.. Large figures, tables and graphs could span across two columns. Please make sure that graphs are clearly readable.
